5th to 6th

1. The theme of this essay is on diversity: What does it mean to you? Describe what diversity can look like? Can you give an example of when you experienced diversity?
2. Answer one of the following: If you could have dinner with any role model, who would it be and why? If you could go anywhere in the world, at any point in history, where would it be and when would it be, and why?

7th to 9th

1. Great leaders are able to reflect on their skills that make them exceptional. Reflect on a time you were a leader. What leadership skills did you demonstrate? What made you a great leader?
2. How would you describe yourself as a leader? (provide 2 examples), and how will DiverseCity help you become a better leader?
